### **Application**

AQUASEAL® UV PLUS is carefully admixed into our AQ-UASEAL® water-based paints shortly before use, maximum 2%. For 2K-paints, ideally before the hardener is introduced. The AQUASEAL® water-based paint is then processed further as described for the respective paint.

Drying the AQUASEAL® water-based paints does not change

### Consumption

Maximum 2% AQUASEAL® UV PLUS is added to the AquSeal® water-based paints.

### Storage / transportation

When transported and stored in a frost-proof, cool and dry place in the original, unopened container, it will usually have a shelf life of at least 6 months.
