AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER is a colorless waterborne wood floor filler, developed for use with fine sanding dust from the parent wood floor.

Use of AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER will achieve an exact wood color match for filling joints, cracks, gaps, nail holes and cavities of any type in a wood surface.

The resulting filler has superb spreading and filling capacity due to its gel structure. AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER is ready to mix, user friendly, non-inflammable and environmentally safe.

Application Instructions

AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER is best used when applied on the next to last cut with the sander. At this time, the surface to be filled must be completely clean and dry. AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER is mixed at approximately 2 parts of filler to 1 part of sanding dust by volume. Mix anew for every job site. Using clean, fine edger dust (80-100 grit is recommended) from the parent wood creates an excellent filler for hardwood floors. Volume ratio may be varied for desired consistency. After mixing for several minutes, AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER will develop into an ultra smooth texture putty which must be applied by a trowel (our trowel is recommended). avoid residual cured material remaining on the surface. Large, deep cavities may require more than one application. Store in a clean plastic container with a tight fitting lid. After sufficiently dry, final sanding cut must be done to obtain a smooth surface without any residues of AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER onto. All tools should be cleaned with water immediately after use.

A sufficient dry can be obtained in $\frac{1}{2} - 1$ hours with a constant temperature of 70° F and 50 % relative air humidity. Insufficient ventilation, lower temperatures and erratic air humidity may prolong sufficient drying. Filler mixture should be used within 8-10 hours.

Maintenance and Care

As applied by trowel, care should be taken to trowel and press AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER into floor. AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER achieves excellent adhesion to a clean, dry surface and will resist 'chipping out' during the final sanding cut. Floor may then be coated with any desired finish.

System Recommendations

Ratio of wood dust to filler can vary and may be adjusted to personal preference.

For optimum results and a brilliant effect on the floor, we recommend the complete AQUACHOICE System: All 1- and 2component waterbased finishes and maintenance products of the current Berger-Seidle product-range. AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER volume once mixed is highly stable with minimum shrinkage in joints. Due to optimal pH value of AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER there is no discoloration by pigments in oak wood (joints will not turn black). Good adhesion can be expected if using other finishes over AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER but testing for compatibility and adhesion should still be conducted. Where a concern exists regarding sidebonding and panelization, use AQUACHOICE FLEXSEALER, AQUACHOICE EXOBLOC or SOLVSEAL UNIQUICKSEALER as a seal coat. For rich, natural color and detailed grain definition, use CLASSIC BASEOIL (in combination with CLASSIC PLUS as an impregnation.

AQUACHOICE POWERFILLER has a shelf life of 15 months from production date.

Safety Precautions

Do not use for sputtering or spraying. Keep out of reach of children. Residual quantities should not be poured into sewage water drains, but disposed of in compliance with local, state, and federal regulations.

General information
